

It's that time of year again! The HVGCSA's premier fundraising event will be held on Wednesday, May 8th at the historic Bedford Golf & Tennis Club in Bedford Village, NY. The Hudson Valley Cup is celebrating its 33rd year as a charity tournament to raise money for scholarships and turfgrass research. This tournament was the brainchild of long time HVGCSA member Dan Madar and it's still going strong. Our host, Bob Nielson, is looking forward to hosting this event and a big turnout. For those of you that haven't had the pleasure of playing Bedford G&T, you are going to fall in love with this old-school golf destination.

The Club

The long and storied history of Bedford Golf & Tennis Club began an astounding 134 years ago in 1890 when a group of young male tennis enthusiasts decided to form a club. The Bedford Lawn Tennis Club opened in June of 1891. The club offered three grass tennis courts, croquet grounds, and a clubhouse. A nine-hole golf course was designed and built by the members and opened in 1896. Things didn't change quickly at the Bedford Golf & Tennis Club and it wasn't until 1926 that the club decided to acquire more land to build a proper golf course. Famed Architect Devereux Emmet was hired and expanded the course to 18 holes. He kept five holes from the original design and built 13 new holes. The course remained unchanged until 1998 when the club hired Architect Ken Dye to tweak the course. Holes 13 & 14 were lengthened by 100 and 80 yards respectively and all the bunkers and greens surrounds were redone. The course plays 6750 yards from the tips and is characterized by the many abrupt elevation changes. Bob describes the course as, "a great member's golf course. The elevation changes make for a fun course to play. You do have to shoot well to score though". Unlike many other golf and country clubs in Westchester County, Bedford Golf & Tennis, from its inception, has remained to this day a family sports club, and nothing more.

Even though there have been no major changes to the golf course since 1998, the club has retained the services of Architect John Harvey who is developing a master plan for the golf course moving forward. Not that there hasn't been major work being done at the club. In August of 2023 the club completed the construction of a new clubhouse. "The old clubhouse was around 60 years old and just wasn't adequate for the needs of the membership," Bob said, "so the intent with building a new facility was to cater to our membership, not to host more weddings and events. We needed a larger and more modern kitchen and the



square footage of the clubhouse increased from 9000 to 16,000 square feet. We also built two employee housing units at the same time."

All About Bob

"I hadn't any intention of getting into golf", Bob remembered, "I was enrolled



at Pace University and had every intention of getting into business". That all changed when Bob started working "on the crew" at Bedford Golf and Tennis in 1982. The superintendent at the time, Terry Boels, who hailed from County Sligo in Ireland, had a thick brogue and although Bob understood him, Terry's relationship with club members could have been described as "two peoples separated by a common language."

Bob became the assistant in 1988 and that year completed the UMASS winter program to further his golf education. In 1991, Bob took over as superintendent. During Bob's tenure, the course underwent the aforementioned Ken Dye renovation which transformed and brought out the beauty of the original Devereux Emmet design and in many people's eyes, enhanced it. "It's a pretty neat golf course", Bob proudly states, "We're not going to host any major golf tournaments but it's a solid layout that's fair and fun to play. You won't lose a lot of golf balls.

2024 marks Bob's 42nd year at the club and his 33rd as superintendent.

Bob has always been one to give back to the industry. Bob was a board member for the MetGCSA for over a decade and served as its President in 2011-2012. Currently Bob is serving as Vice President for NYSTA and as President of the NY Golf Course Foundation which was born out of the establishment of BMP's and sustainability for the golf course industry, a project spearheaded by Bob, Blake Halderman, Ken Benoit, Frank Rossi and Cornell University. Bob was recognized by the GCSAA a few years back as the recipient of the "Excellence in Government Relations" Award. Bob is also hard at work creating a new association, a golf alliance which will involve superintendents, golf pro's, GM's, and golf course owners all geared towards speaking with one voice when dealing with Governor, Assembly, and State Senate in Albany.

Family

As Bob remembers it, "I met my wife Carolyn 21 years ago. I was out with my friend Haik (Bobby's sometimes partner in crime and the former head chef at Bedford Golf & Tennis) at a bar. He went over to Carolyn and her friends and asked them to sit with us". The rest is history.
