Country Club at Otterkill to Host May Meeting

On Tuesday, May 12th, Superintendent Frank Betro and Otterkill CC will host the HVGCSA's May meeting. The last time Otterkill hosted the HVGCSA was in 2010 for the Hudson Valley Cup. Frank and his family (who own the club) are looking forward to a big turnout and a great day on the links for the association's members and guests.

All About Frank



Frank was born in Goshen, NY in 1990, not far from the club. The Betro family are firmly established in Goshen. Frank's dad Joseph is currently the Town Supervisor and owns and operates Delancey's, a local bar and restaurant in Goshen. In addition, the Betro family operates two local catering venues for weddings and events. In 2016, Joseph purchased Otterkill CC with the intent of expanding the family catering business and improving the golf course and the property.

Frank's foray into golf was a little later than most. "I went to Johnson & Wales University and graduated with a degree in Business Management," Frank said, "in 2013, I went to work for a company called Telecon Solutions. To tell you the truth, I didn't like my job. When my dad bought Otterkill, I went to work at the club in the kitchen."

Frank got to know and like Jason Werbalowsky, the superintendent of Otterkill at the time the family bought the club. "I ended up working on the grounds crew for Jason," Frank said, "I worked my way up and learned every aspect of golf course maintenance. Jason was my mentor. Eventually, I became the superintendent. This is my 5th season in that role and I love it"

Frank takes care of the 136-acre property with a crew of nine. One of the more positive improvements on the golf course has been the installation of a new Toro Links irrigation system three years ago. The clubhouse has undergone renovations and improvements. A new pool and banquet area have been added. "We have a great membership," said Frank, "we persevere to keep everything in great shape for them."

On a personal note, Frank and his wife Emily live locally and have a 4-year old son Robert and a 1-year old daughter Helen.

The Course

A William Mitchell design, Otterkill opened its doors for play in 1957. The par-72 course plays 6,850 yards from the back tees. The course rating is 73.8 and the slope is 139. Since 2000, the course has hosted US Amateur, the MGA's "Ike", and NY State Open qualifiers.

The course will most likely be played at a shorter yardage for the meeting, we hope!! The tournament committee has been showcasing our Orange and Sullivan County courses the past few years. Please show your support. We hope to see you at the meeting on 5/12.

2026 Turfgrass Advocacy Day - A Success!

Monday, March 9th was a big day in Albany, when NYSTA held our 2026 Turfgrass Advocacy Day. Following a morning briefing and group discussion with NYS Agriculture Commissioner Richard Ball, Deputy Commissioner Elizabeth Wolters, Renee St. Jacques of NY Farm Bureau, and NYS Deputy Secretary for Agriculture and Environment Ashley Dougherty, over 60 industry professionals met with over 62 legislative leaders to spread the word about our concerns and to advocate for a NYS Budget restoration of the Turfgrass Environmental Stewardship Fund line item. Later in the afternoon, we were also joined by Assemblywoman Donna Lupardo who will be retiring from the Assembly at the end of 2026. Assemblywoman Lupardo has always been a strong supporter of NYSTA and the Turfgrass Environmental Stewardship Fund and we were happy to present her with NYSTA's 2026 Friend of the Green Industry Award.
